## Toastmasters International's global membership continues to rise

Reports strongest growth in corporate sector

The global leader in public speaking and leadership skills development reports increases in both membership and clubs around the world with more than 280,000 members, 13,500 plus clubs, and a surge in corporate clubs.

Toastmasters chartered a record number of 1,292 new clubs for the year, a 3.6% increase over last year. The popularity of Toastmasters' corporate clubs also continues to climb, with 537 forming. This represents a 71% increase over the previous year. Worldwide there are now more than 4,000 corporate clubs operating in companies such as <a href="Bank of America">Bank of America</a>, <a href="Facebook">Facebook</a> and <a href="Google">Google</a>.

According to a recent survey conducted by Toastmasters, 71% of members join to improve their public speaking skills, while 42% seek to improve their interpersonal communication. Additionally, four countries — Bangladesh, Latvia, Malta and the Republic of Moldova — added Toastmasters clubs for the first time.
