## 102 Toastmasters Advance to Semifinals of World's Largest Speech Contest

The World Championship of Public Speaking® comes to Vancouver in August

RANCHO SANTA MARGARITA, Calif., Aug. 02, 2017 — After six months of rigorous competition, 102 contestants have risen from a pool of more than 30,000 participants from over 100 countries to earn their spot in the semifinals of the Toastmasters International Speech Contest. The competition takes place at the organization's 86<sup>th</sup> Annual International Convention, held Aug. 23-26 at the Vancouver Convention Centre.

The 102 speech contestants from Toastmasters districts around the world advanced to the semifinals after surviving four earlier rounds of elimination through club, area, division and district speech competitions. Their five- to seven-minute speeches were judged on content, organization, gestures and style.

The semifinals take place Aug. 24, where 10 finalists will emerge and compete again the following day in the <u>Toastmasters World Championship of Public Speaking</u>.

"The International Speech Contest brings some of the best speakers in the world together as they compete for the coveted title of Toastmasters World Champion of Public Speaking," says Mike Storkey, Toastmasters 2016-2017 International President.
